

CLIMATE ACTION SUB-COMMITTEE TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. Introduction

- 1.1 At Full Council on the 11th May 2022, it was agreed to set up a Sub-Committee to deliberate on the issues relating to the Town Council's Climate Action Plan.
- 1.2 It was further agreed that the Sub-Committee would be responsible to the Policy and Finance Committee.

2. Delegation

2.1 As a decision-making body of the Council the Sub-Committee can resolve matters within its remit, although the Sub-Committee has no expenditure authority, and expenditure must be recommended to Policy and Finance Committee for approval.

3. Membership

- 3.1 The Sub-Committee shall comprise of six Councillors.
- 3.2 Membership shall be elected by Full Council or Policy and Finance Committee.

4. Meetings

- 4.1 Meetings shall take place during daytime office hours.
- 4.2 If practicable, meetings shall be held two weeks prior to Policy and Finance Committee meetings.

5. Procedures

- 5.1 The Sub-Committee shall operate within Ludlow Town Council's Standing Orders, Financial Regulations, Local Government Law and these Terms of Reference.
- 5.2 At the first meeting of each Council year the Sub-Committee will appoint a Chair and Vice Chair from its appointed membership. The Chair and Vice Chair may be re-elected.
- 5.3 The Sub-Committee shall report directly and submit meeting minutes and reports to the Policy and Finance Committee for ratification and adoption.

- 5.4 The Town Clerk shall set the agenda in consultation with the Chair of the Sub-Committee.
- 5.5 The Town Clerk and Deputy Town Clerk shall provide administrative support to the Sub-Committee.

6. Sub-Committee Functions and Remit

- 6.1 A remit to monitor and facilitate the delivery of the Climate Action Plan.
- 6.2 A remit to undertake community engagement through:
 - Invitations to members of other related groups to advise on specified matters.
 - Providing accessible and accurate information to assist residents of Ludlow to make changes to reduce their carbon footprint.

7. Activities outside the Scope of the Climate Action Sub-Committee

- 7.1 The Sub-Committee will not duplicate the existing work of the Council where existing structures and processes are in place.
- 7.2 Revisions to the agreed Climate Action Plan will be dealt with by the Council.
